### Our Mission

To work together with the School Leadership to help create a conducive learning environment for our children, the students of Ambassador School, Dubai.

### Our Goals

Our **primary goal** is to act as a bridge between the parent community and school management to:

- Discuss proposals that would lead to enhanced learning for the entire student community
- Provide suggestions to further improve school administration, infrastructure, academics and other activities; provide constructive feedback on existing processes and new initiatives taken by the school
- Interact and support new parents and help them and their children in the school community
- Assist in fostering a collaborative approach between parents and the school towards developing all-round education for children e.g. conducting events and activities through pro-active involvement of parents.

Our **other goals** include, but are not limited to:

- Collaborative participation in the organisation of relevant school events, wherever appropriate
- Organise workshops or other events to enhance student learning and awareness of social issues, careers etc
- Maintain a database of parent volunteers willing to contribute time and effort for school / PSG events and activities
- Organise fundraising activities involving the school to support social causes
- Organise free activities on a regular basis (like language or computer courses) for social empowerment of underprivileged people.
- Support school in organising internships, excursions, field trips etc

### Our Members

PSG is a group of like-minded people, whose focus is to work co-operatively with the school management to improve the quality of education for our children. Membership is by nomination by the school leadership team. Parents willing to devote time and effort to help improve the school can volunteer to support the PSG.

There are no hierarchies in the group. All members have equal rights to raise issues and propose solutions. Responsibilities will be mutually agreed upon and suitably shared. Some members may choose to contribute primarily online, because of their time constraints.

### **Code of Conduct for Members**

The credibility of PSG with both parents and the school management will depend a lot on the conduct of its members. PSG should not be used to resolve personal issues or further personal ambitions. Personal issues should be taken up with the school as a parent, not as a PSG member. Similarly, PSG issues should be taken up with the school as a PSG representative, not as an individual.

### **Work methods**

- to carry out the activities of PSG :

- From the school website, a link from Ambassador School, giving information to the parents about PSG.
- Regular internal meetings to discuss issues; minutes of the meetings recorded and posted online. Tasks defined, assigned and followed up.
- Periodic meetings with school management to provide feedback, suggestions etc.
- Minimal funds are required for PSG work and will be raised through suitable methods decided by the members.
